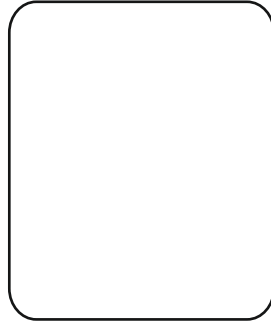

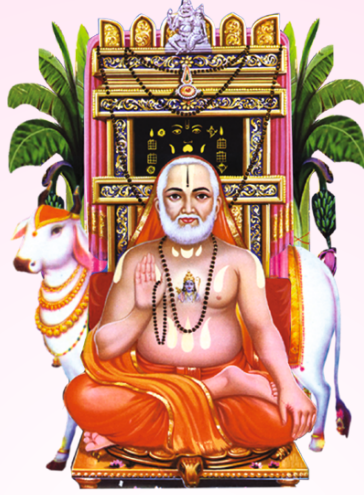

## **ASSEMBLY**

Assembly plays a very important role in a school day as it is informative. It educates and reminds the students of their responsibilities and also inculcates values.

## **SPECIAL DAYS & EVENTS**

Special days and events are an important part of the academic programme of the children. On such days parents are invited to be a part of the special day activities. We strongly recommend that parents encourage the children by being pro-active and attending these Special Days and Events.

## **HOUSE SYSTEM**

The school is divided into four 'Houses'. This main aim of the house system is to provide training in qualities of leadership, co-operation, mutual understanding and self reliance. Different types of competitions and activities are organized under the house system such as dramatics, elocution, quiz, recitation, debate, group song and dance. Predetermined inter house competitions are conducted throughout the year and the house with the maximum number of points is declared and the winner during the Annual Sports Meet. The house with the highest aggregate scores wins the inter-house championship cup.

## Age Criteria for the Admission

The Minimum age for admission as on the 31st day of July of the year of admission shall be

- (i) Pre KG, completed Two years of age
- (ii) for LKG, completed three years of age
- (iii) for UKG, completed four years of age
- (iv) for Grade I, completed five years of age, and for Grade II, completed six years of age and so upto Grade XII

## CODE OF CONDUCT

### ❖ PUNCTUALITY

- (a) Student who are late to school miss vital parts of the programme. Hence the students are expected to be in the school 10 minutes before school time (8.50 am).

### ❖ ATTENDANCE AND ABSENTEEISM

- (a) It is important to have a minimum of 85% attendance for the entire academic year. It is mandatory for students to attend the first (1st) and the last day of school (i.e. before and after every vacation). If due to unavoidable circumstances they are unable to do so, written permission of the Principal is needed before the child can attend the academic session.
- (b) For any other day of **absence the parents should submit a written explanation in the diary**. If sick leave is being mentioned and it is for more than 3 days, the parent should submit a doctor's certificate. Half day or early leave for students will be permitted at the discretion of the management and principal.

### ❖ BEHAVIOUR AND ETHICS

- (a) All students are responsible to the school authorities for their behaviour, both in and outside the school premises. Any untoward action or behaviour on the part of the student shall render them liable for disciplinary actions.
- (b) Fighting, bullying, creation disturbances, denying use of facilities to others, and/or acting in such a manner as to risk injury to others, using threats or intimidation against others, theft, or any other unlawful activity will not be excused.
- (c) Students are instructed to respect the property of others, to keep all books, facilities, equipment and other materials used in the school in good condition and to refrain from damaging school property and / or the property of others. No student should scratch or spoil the desks or chairs, school furniture or fixtures, curtains, walls etc. or in any way damage things belonging to others.

❖ **ESSENTIALS TO BE CARRIED ALL GRADE STUDENTS**

- (a) Labeled school bag
- (b) School diary
- (c) Reader (when provided by school)
- (d) Simple pencil box with sharpened pencils, eraser, ruler, sharpener, etc.
- (e) Geometric box
- (f) Water bottle
- (g) Home work books ( to be carried on the day of submission )

❖ **THINGS NOT PERMITTED IN SCHOOL**

- (a) Expensive and flashy items like fancy watches, jewellery, pens, etc.
- (b) Electronic items like iPods, cell phones, Discman/Walkman, PSP, Game boy, CDs, CD player, hand held video games, etc.
- (c) Toys, balls and sporting equipment not related to sports.
- (d) Inappropriate books, magazines, cassettes, etc. with racist, communal or obscene literature or images.

❖ **DISCIPLINE POLICY**

- (a) All students are held responsible for their own behaviour. When a student needs to be disciplined for violating school rules, the decision of the school management will be final in these matters.

❖ **PARENTS TEACHER MEET - PTM**

- (a) Parents teacher meets are scheduled in June, November & March. The parents get an opportunity to go through the class work sheets, assessment sheets, and other work done by the child in school. All aspect academic and non-academic related to the child are discussed during this meeting.
- (b) PTM dates will be communicated to the parents through circulars. Parents will be allotted a time slot to meet the teachers, parents are expected to adhere to their allotted times to avoid causing any kind of inconvenience to themselves and other parents.

❖ **Note : It is compulsory for parents to attend the PTM**

❖ **SECURITY:**

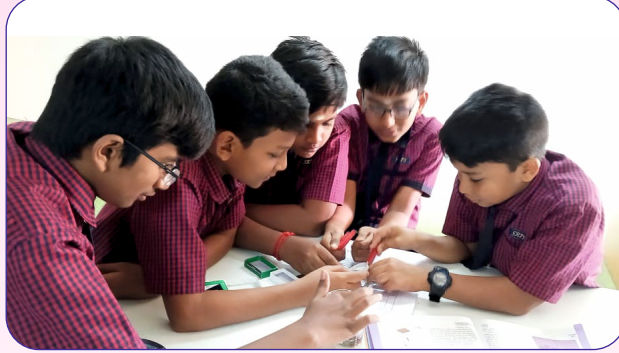
- (a) Our aim is to provide a safe secure environment for our students, staff and visitors.
- (b) All parents /visitors to take an appointment to meet with a member of staff and are expected to come to the security cabin at the main gate, sign in the visitors book and wear a visitors badge and report to help desk.
- (c) Kindly note that the staff has the right to challenge visitors who are not wearing visitor's badge.

❖ **UNIFORM**

- (a) Children should wear regular uniforms on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. On Wednesday & Saturday sports uniform dress has to be weared.

❖ **TRANSPORTATION:**

- (a) School vehicle has an attendant who will accompany the students on all routes. Parents are requested to be at the stop 5 minutes earlier.
- (b) The suitability of a route to school will be assessed by the bus operator which will depend on the distance, load factors and road condition.
- (c) Students will be collected as near to their homes as 'possible' distance to meet the transport. The pickup point will be determined by the bus contractor. The responsibility for ensuring a child's safe in getting to and from the picking up/ setting down point rests with the parent.
- (d) Students who show aggressive behaviour, creating disturbance and /or acting in such a manner as to risk injury to themselves and others in the bus, disciplinary action will be taken.

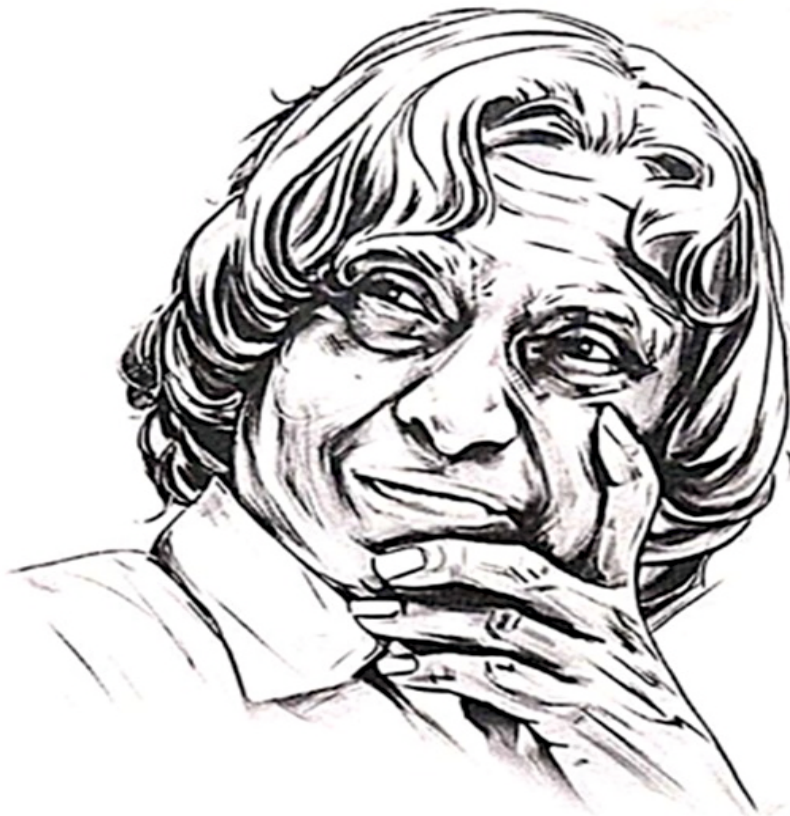
